

Portal for online application for Compulsory Registration

Department of Electronics and Information Technology delightfully announces its portal entitled “Electronics Standards of India” for filing of online applications under “Electronics & Information Technology Goods (Requirements for Compulsory Registration) Order, 2012”.

The order was notified by DeitY on 3rd October, 2012 mandating 15 categories of electronic products under **Compulsory Registration Scheme of Department of Consumer Affairs** based on their compliance to Indian safety standards. While the applications were being received manually so far, to fulfil its transparency obligation under the notified order, DeitY has put in place this portal which is accessible on URL: <http://electronicstds.gov.in/> .

The portal will enable industry applicants to file applications for registration wherein they will have to first register themselves onto the portal along with address authentication document. After authenticating the same, the user id created by the applicant will be activated and an e-mail alert will be sent to the user.

Portal also has put in place the system for application by labs for seeking recognition from BIS.

It is also envisaged to build a mechanism based on due intelligence and minimizing the human interface in the portal to put in place an effective and efficient surveillance system of drawing and testing of samples at a later stage.

Whereas attempts are being made to feed the data of the applications received manually so far into the system, the applicants in their own interest are hereby advised to register themselves and file their applications online also which will enable them to derive benefits of the status updating mechanism built in the portal for the applications submitted through the portal.
